

Importing Names

Many Gifts can save lots of time by importing names from another source.

Congregations may use a church management software program, a database, or a spreadsheet to manage names. Most of these programs have a way of exporting data into another format. **Check the help files for the other program that is the source of names. Look for exporting data or “saving as” another format.**

Many Gifts recognizes dBase (e.g. names.dbf) and Paradox (e.g. names.db) tables. It also recognizes delimited text files (e.g., names.txt) or comma delimited files (e.g. names.csv).


Many Gifts needs to have a separate field of information for Last Name and First Name. Preferably there will also be a Middle Name. Fields or columns of information will be matched to *Many Gifts* field names during the import. (*Many Gifts* can also import addresses and contact information. See the Help files for more information.)

Many Gifts can import the following types of files. Here is what they might look like.

This shows a typical dBase table. A Paradox table would be similar.





When you have figured out how to export names from another program, you are ready to begin the import process from *Many Gifts*.


1. Select the *Names* option in the *Modules* menu.

2. Click and select the *Import Names* tab.



3. Review the information. You cannot import names if any surveys have been entered. (Press *Help* or *F1* to learn more.)


4. Click on *Import Wizard*.



5. Click on *Select File*.




6. Select the file containing the names that you exported from another software program. You may need to navigate to another directory where you saved the file.



7. Click on **Open**.


8. If you have selected a delimited text or csv (comma delimited) file, you will see this screen. Answer the question. (If you selected a dBase or Paradox file, go to Step 15.)



9. Sometimes the first row is a list of field names that does not need to be imported?

10. Click on **Next**.

11. Make sure the option on the right matches the contents of the field to the left using the drop-down lists.



12. Move from record to record if helpful in determining the match.

13. Click on **Next**.

- 14 Check that the information is correct and click on **Finish**.




